



# Poplar

(*Populus*)

Poplar, a less well-known sauna material, belongs to the same genus of broadleaf as aspen (*Populus tremula*). Natural poplar wood has a pale yellow tone and a smooth texture. As poplar is similar to aspen both in terms of appearance and features, it is perfect for building a sauna. In Thermory's product range, poplar comes in thermally modified form.

## Features of poplar sauna materials by Thermory

- ▶ Poplar is suitable for sauna benches as it does not secrete resin or produce splinters, and there are no exposed knots on the boards, which do not overheat.
- ▶ Thermal modification makes the wood more durable, moisture resistant, and stable. The treatment also provides the wood with a beautiful light brown shade, which makes the room very warm and cosy.
- ▶ Wide boards allow for a sauna room with a more luxurious design.
